Northwood Park Pool No. 4 2017 Season Rules, Regulations, and Policies

The following rules and regulations have been established to ensure a safe and enjoyable pool environment for all members and their guests. Please share these rules with all family members and guests prior to the use of the Pool 4 facility. Rules are subject to change. Please consult a staff member for clarification. Violation of any of the pool rules can result in the suspension or elimination of a membership.

General Rules:

- 1) THE LIFEGUARD or onsite STAFF MEMBER IS TO BE OBEYED AT ALL TIMES. Disobeying a lifeguard can result in loss of membership.
- 2) No running walk slowly.
- 3) Children under 7, or children that are not water safe, must be ACTIVELY supervised by an ADULT at All times.
- 4) The association is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- The pool may be cleared at any time at the discretion of personnel (lifeguard / board member).
- 6) Everyone must shower prior to entering the pool and after putting on sunscreen.
- Ice chests (coolers) and bags will be inspected for glass and alcoholic beverages at time of entry or anytime at the pool.
- 8) No boom boxes or loud radios allowed.
- 9) No smoking is permitted at Pool 4 PROPERTY (not in the: walkway entrance, pool, on pool deck (all cement areas), all grassy areas, picnic area or restrooms.)
- 10) No pets allowed except for service animals as defined by ADA.

Behavior Guidelines:

- 11) Foul language will not be tolerated at any time.
- 12) No pushing, pulling, shoving, chicken-fights or horseplay on the deck or in the pool. No grabbing around the neck.
- 13) No loitering in the gatehouse or restrooms.
- 14) No hanging on the ropes, lane lines or pole.
- 15) No bicycles, skateboards, etc. are to be ridden in to pool area.

Swim Attire:

- 16) Everyone must wear appropriate and clean swimwear. All shorts and shirts must be hemmed.
- 17) If not wearing a swim cap, shoulder length hair (or longer) must be braided or rubber banded. Rubber bands maybe available at the gatehouse.
- 18) Babies and non-potty trained toddlers must wear rubber pants or special swim pants/disposable swim diapers while in the pool. Swim diapers are for sale at the gatehouse.

Diving Rules & Equipment:

- 19) No swimming in deep end while diving board is open.
- 20) No climbing or diving off of lifeguard stands.
- 21) No diving in the shallow area or jumping off or over the top steps.
- 22) Maximum weight of individual on diving board must be less than 250 lbs.
- 23) Only one bounce permitted on the diving board.
- 24) Only one person at a time permitted on the diving board.
- 25) **No Flips of any kind** are allowed off diving board or from the pool deck. No diving of any kind off side of diving board. No leaving the board backwards. No hanging off the diving board.
- 26) Look and wait until person in front of you gets out of deep end before going off diving board.
- 27) Artificial swimming aids and water play equipment are allowed at the discretion of pool personnel.
- 28) No flotation devices are allowed in the deep end at any time.
- 29) No hard balls are allowed in the pool (example: football, baseball, racquetball balls, tennis balls).

Guests and Non-Members:

- 30) Members may have guests for a fee of \$2 per guest (swimming or non-swimming). Members are responsible for informing their guests of NPIA#4 pool rules prior to use of the pool facilities.
- 31) **Members are responsible for their guests and their actions.** Non-compliance of pool rules by members or guests may result in ejection from the facility or the revocation of your pool membership.
- 32) Guests must be accompanied by an adult pool member (Age 18 or over) at all times.

Parties (see Party flier for complete rules):

- 33) An adult Pool #4 member must be with the party guests for the entire duration of the party.
- 34) All non-members must leave the pool premises at the time indicated by the hosting Pool #4 member on the party form.
- 35) Lifequard fees are \$20 per hour per lifequard if your group exceeds 9 members (subject to change by Supervisor).
- 36) Party Guests will not be allowed into the facility until: a) the hosting Pool #4 member is present and b) it is the scheduled Party start time

Food & Beverages:

- 37) Food and beverages are not permitted in the pool or on the pool deck area.
- 38) NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL are allowed on the premises at any time.
- 39) NO GLASS or CERAMIC containers of any kind (such as casserole dishes, glass bottled waters, seltzers and juices) is permitted.

Recreational Equipment:

- 40) Members need to present their membership card/or an ID to check out pool provided equipment (shuffle board, ping pong, volley ball).
- 41) Member will be subject to replacement cost if volleyball is lost or not returned (\$25.00).
